All Best in Show judging on Saturday will follow Show C on Saturday and Show E on Sunday

In honor and memory of our longtime friends and founding members, Gerry and Edna Moulton, we are having our 7th annual Youth Breeder Contest.

- Contest is open to youth breeders only ONE Entry per Exhibitor
- No Entry fees.
- Age groups Novice (5-9), Intermediate (10-14), Senior (15-18)
- Contestants should be prepared to answer questions about their animal and its care to prove to this year's judges that he/she has bred the animal and how it has improved their program.
- A youth's entry may be a purchased animal. However, the youth will have to explain why it was purchased and how the animal will improve their overall breeding program.
- Winner will receive a special award.
- Register at the secretary's table and indicate age and rabbit or cavy.
- Our Judges this year will be:
 - o Danny Long, Peter Velchek and Emily Ashton for Rabbits
 - Sandy Carpenter and Paul Jurgelonis for Cavies

Day of Show Procedures

- Parking, loading and unloading will be through the south side of the venue (Facing the main road, same side as Bass Pro): Directly in front of the outside doors should be kept clear for emergency vehicles and everyone else loading / unloading.
 - There should be NO ANIMALS COMING THROUGH THE MALL!
- There will be NO SETTING UP EXHIBITOR AREAS before the show equipment setup is complete.
- Check the schedule and notice boards for times when you must have your animals checked in and where your breed will be shown. Listen for loudspeaker announcements for breed starts.
 - Your check in sheet will be emailed to you by the Easy2Show.
 - PLEASE PRINT YOUR OWN CHECK-IN SHEETS, we will not have them.
 - DAY OF SHOW / SIGN-IN will be paused at 8:45 to 9:15 to get the show started!!
 - There will be no Day of Show Entries on Saturday morning for SHOW A. Friday night is the LAST CALL for late entries.
 - ALL ENTRIES ARE FROZEN 1 HOUR AFTER EACH SHOW HAS BEGUN!!
- SUBSTITUTIONS: Per ARBA rules these are ear number changes only and must be done before judging starts. A form will be available at the Secretary's table to submit these changes.
 - NO DAY OF |SHOW CHANGES IN SEX, VARIETY, and OR CLASS: This is a *Late Entry*, not a substitution. Forms will be available at the Secretary's table to make late entries.

• NO CHANGES AT THE JUDGING TABLE

• All show folders need to REMAIN at the Secretary desk before and after judging.

REMARK CARDS

Remark Cards will NOT be prepared for open or youth. We will have cards available for the use of the exhibitors who wish to fill out their own and take down their own comments or provide a second writer at the table. With one writer at the table, we need their attention focused on the control sheets for accuracy. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation

INFO FOR REGISTERING RABBITS & CAVIES

- Please bring a copy of the correctly completed pedigree.
- Please bring your ARBA card
- Please bring \$6 correct change
- If you are bringing legs to Grand a rabbit after Registering, please have \$4 correct change that goes to ARBA, The registrar only need the legs please don't bring the whole printed leg, they don't need it.
- Please let the registrar know how many rabbits you are bringing to register (*Name / Contact on Page 2*). They will be glad to check your pedigree over for error if you want to send them in attachment. Your pedigree only needs; Name of rabbit you are registering, ear number, sex, variety, date of birth of the animal you are registering, parents, grandparents & great grand parents don't need date of birth.
- ARBA does not accept handwritten notes on pedigree or full pedigrees that are hand written, if you don't have computerized program please allow time for you to fill out the whole form.
- Please come early when the show room opens to get rabbits registered. It's hard to register if you are showing. Bring all your information and they start the process and you can come back and sign the form while you have time between shows.
- Please remember to look over the form. We are all human and can miss things or transpose letters, numbers, leave an item blank by accident and write something wrong.

SHOW RULES

- This show is an official **ARBA sanctioned event** and will be governed by the current show rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. The filing of an entry from indicates the acceptance of these rules:

- All Rabbits must have a permanent and legible ear mark; cavies must have ear tags. **Rabbits will be judged by private ear number. Please make sure they are legible.** Exhibitors may have their own earmarks, that is your business, but they don't count.

- CLARCC will not be responsible for any loss or injury to animals, humans (or nonhumans?) in case of fire, accidents, providential destruction, zombie apocalypse, time or space warps, alien abduction etc. Exhibitors and guests assume all risk of entering animals and being on the property.

- Exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to and from the table. Breeds will not be re-judged because of late arrivals. In order not to cause delays, classes will wait no longer than 3 minutes or 3 calls and CLARCC thanks you for your donation in that event.

- CLARCC reserves the right to substitute judges, staff, officers, awards. Sorry, we can't substitute exhibitors or the weather.

Anyone causing a disturbance or intimidating a judges or staff will be removed from the showroom and their entries forfeited. There will be no breeding of rabbits, or humans for that matter, in the show room.
Entry fee must accompany entry at check-in or entry will be returned to the exhibitor. Any checks not clearing the bank will be assessed a \$35.00 fee and a really stern look.

- Children must be in the care of an adult to ensure they don't disrupt exhibitors and their animals, no caging of children is allowed, no matter how unruly they get. Any child left unattended may result in the caregiver being asked to leave. Children should NOT be playing with other person equipment. Caregivers will be held financially responsible for any damage and may be declined future shows.

- CLARCC reserves the right to ask ANYONE to leave the show room, and yes, we do mean ANYONE!
- No alcoholic beverages (judges, exhibitors, or staff) at the judging table while the show is in session.
Please drink responsibly or don't drink at all.

- No smoking in the showroom or the mall per NYS law and Finger Lakes Mall Policy. Please STEP AWAY from the exterior doors when smoking.

- Sick animals should NOT be brought into the showroom. Sick animals will be removed from the showroom and entry fees will be forfeited. Determination of "sick" will at the discretion of the show superintendent.

- Ribbons and awards must be picked up at the show. They will not be mailed. Postage costs too much.

- Any exhibitor under the age of 5 years must show in OPEN class per ARBA rules.

- Carriers must have leak proof bottoms. If exhibitor leakage is anticipated, leak proof bottoms are also recommended however there are restrooms in the event center for your convenience.

- Carriers / Chairs / Grooming tables / For Sale boards / Children / Humans / Alien Guests, etc. are to be placed in designated areas only. Walkways will be indicated and need to remain clear of obstructions for everyone's safety. Cage wire makes a painful landing place when you trip and fall.

- Excluding Service Animals, **please DO NOT BRING any pets other than rabbits or cavies** to the showroom, they become a distraction. If absolutely necessary to bring them, pre-approval from the show staff is required. Non-show animals WILL be removed if causing a disturbance.

- Service animals are welcome but should be ALWAYS readily identifiable as such and with the handler - Overnight parking is in the parking lot IS NOT ALLOWED and local police do patrol the area. There nearby places you can go if you need to sleep in your car.

- Per ARBA show rule 15(2) CLARCC must refuse entries from exhibitors placing an entry from all locations within 25 miles, which had a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD in wild / feral rabbits within the past 30 days of the entry deadline.
